1.0 GREETINGS/APPRECIATION

We thank God for seeing us through to the end of this term and we also appreciate your support and partnership.

1.0 VACATION AND RESUMPTION

The school vacates on Thursday 11th April, 2019 for end of first term holiday. Students are required to resume on Sunday 28th April, 2019 from 12:00pm to 6:00pm.

2.0 WORN-OUT/OUTGROWN UNIFORMS

We request that parents should check their children's uniform to ensure that the children's worn-out and outgrown uniforms are replaced. The accepted length of girls' skirts is knee length. Any skirt above the knee is undersize and should be replaced. Parents are also enjoined to discourage their children from slim fitting their skirts and pair of trousers or wearing any uniform that belongs to other students, especially if the uniform bears the name of another student. Uniforms that fall into these categories shall be confiscated.

3.0 SCHOOL SHOES AND SANDALS

Every student is required to have two pairs of lace-up black shoes as well as two pairs of sandals. It has been observed that students are sometimes compelled by circumstances to wear bathroom slippers when their shoes/sandals get spoilt if they have only one pair of shoes/sandals.

4.0 HAIR CUT FOR BOYS

Boys are reminded to bring their clippers to school as they must keep low and tidy hair always. It is safer to use personal clippers for haircut. The school clipper will be used if a student fails to bring his/her personal clipper.

Boys should have a decent low haircut when resuming (step 1 attachment of the barbing set should be used) when resuming.

5.0 END OF TERM ASSIGNMENTS

End of term assignments are enclosed in every child's envelope. We enjoin parents to guide their children in doing the assignments before resumption.

6.0 ONLINE ACADEMIC RESULT CHECKER

Parents are required to check their child's results online, using the child's surname (i.e Username) and admission number (i.e Password). Please visit the school website for the link to access the result from Monday, 15th April, 2019. In case of any difficulty in checking your child's result, please, contact our ICT

8.0 HEALTH MATTERS/IMMUNIZATION

The immunization of students against various diseases, such as Hepatitis B, Measles, Rubella & Mumps (MMR) commenced in the second half of this term. Parents who want their children to be immunized should indicate their interest in the immunization consent form enclosed in the child's envelope.

Parents are advised to treat their children for malaria and also deworm them before they resume school.

9.0 EXTENSION CLASSES FOR YEAR 12 AND YEAR 9 STUDENTS

In order to adequately prepare the Year 12 and 9 students for SSCE and BECE respectively, their extension classes will hold from 11th April to 27th April, 2019. Parents of Year 12 and Year 9 **students** can visit their children in school on Easter Sunday, 21st April, 2019 from 12 noon to 4:00pm.

10.0 WEST AFRICAN SENIOR SCHOOL CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION (WASSCE) and UNIFIED TERTIARY MATRICULATION EXAMINATION (UTME).

WASSCE started on Monday 8th April, 2019. Also, the 2019 Unified Tertiary Matriculation Examination (UTME) will take place between the 11th -13th of April, 2019. The students are well prepared and we are sure of resounding success by the grace of God.

10.1 IGCSE BILL FOR YEAR 11 STUDENTS
